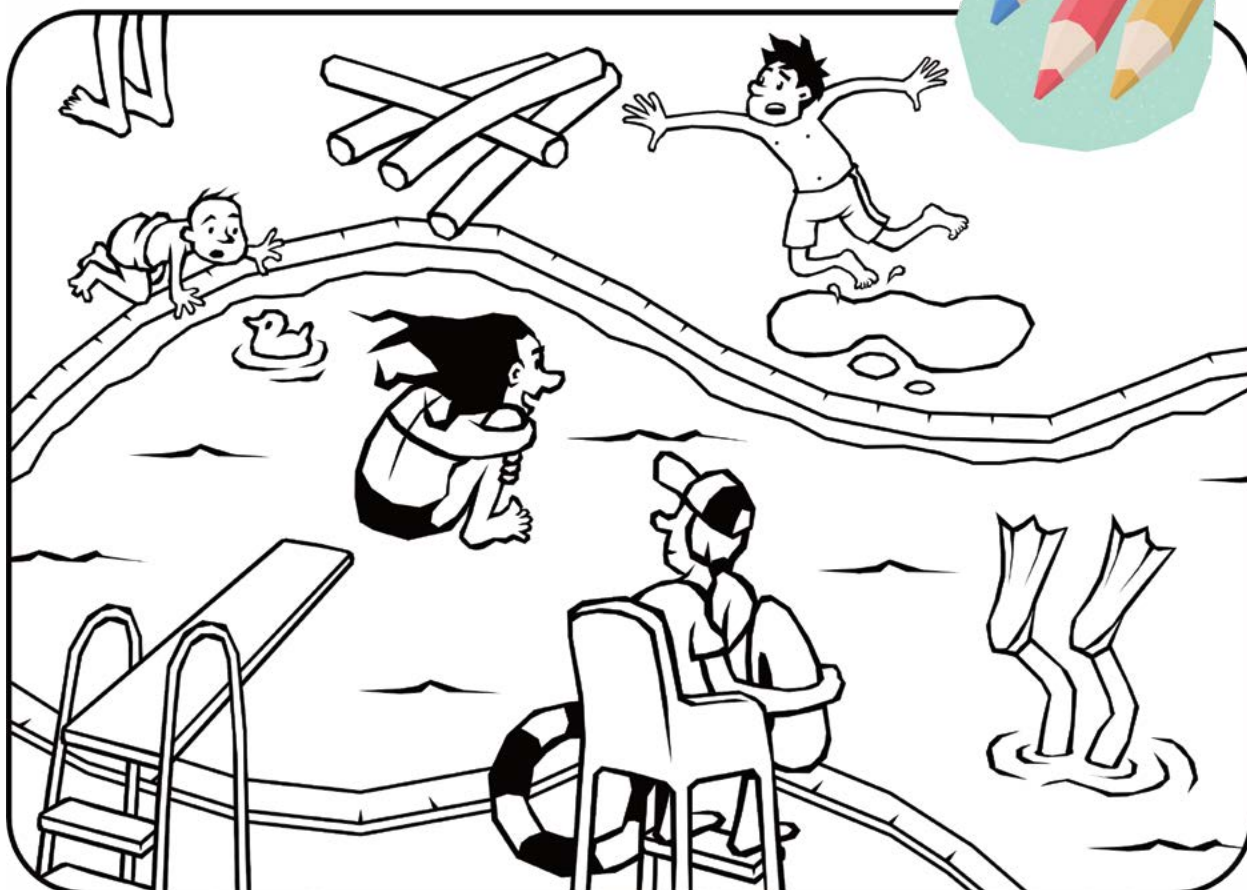
Mummy promised me a special treat,

pool to meet Daddy and Alex.

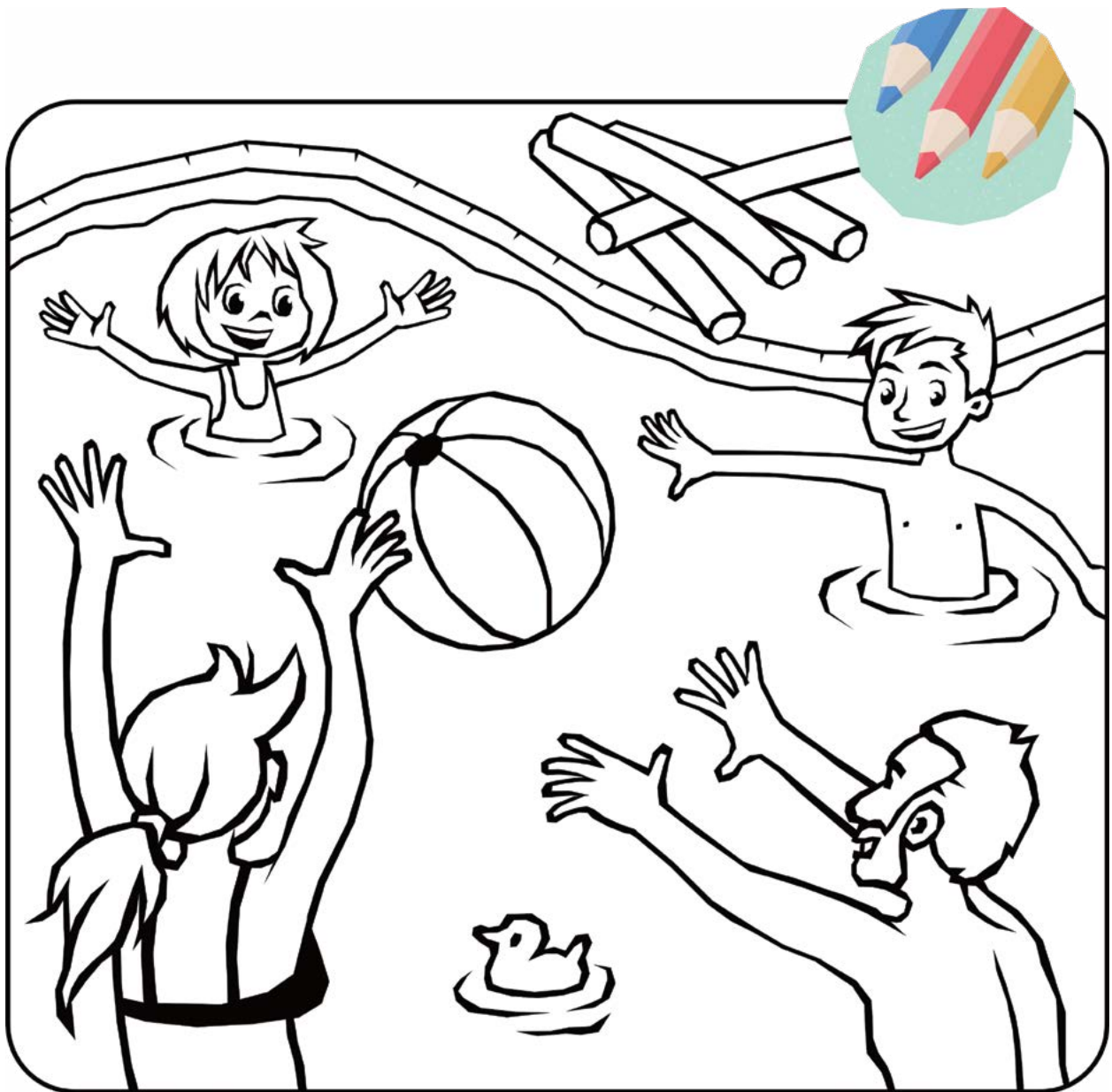


**Sometimes, in an emergency, an adult might ask you to help them take their medicine. Remember to NEVER play with medicines!**

I found the reception desk where a nice lady was sitting. She was very friendly and asked me if I needed any help.

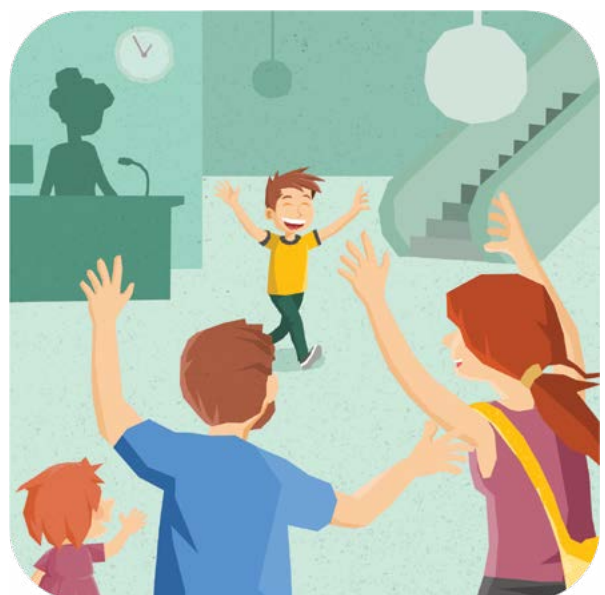


I told her, "I can't find my

Ambulance worker

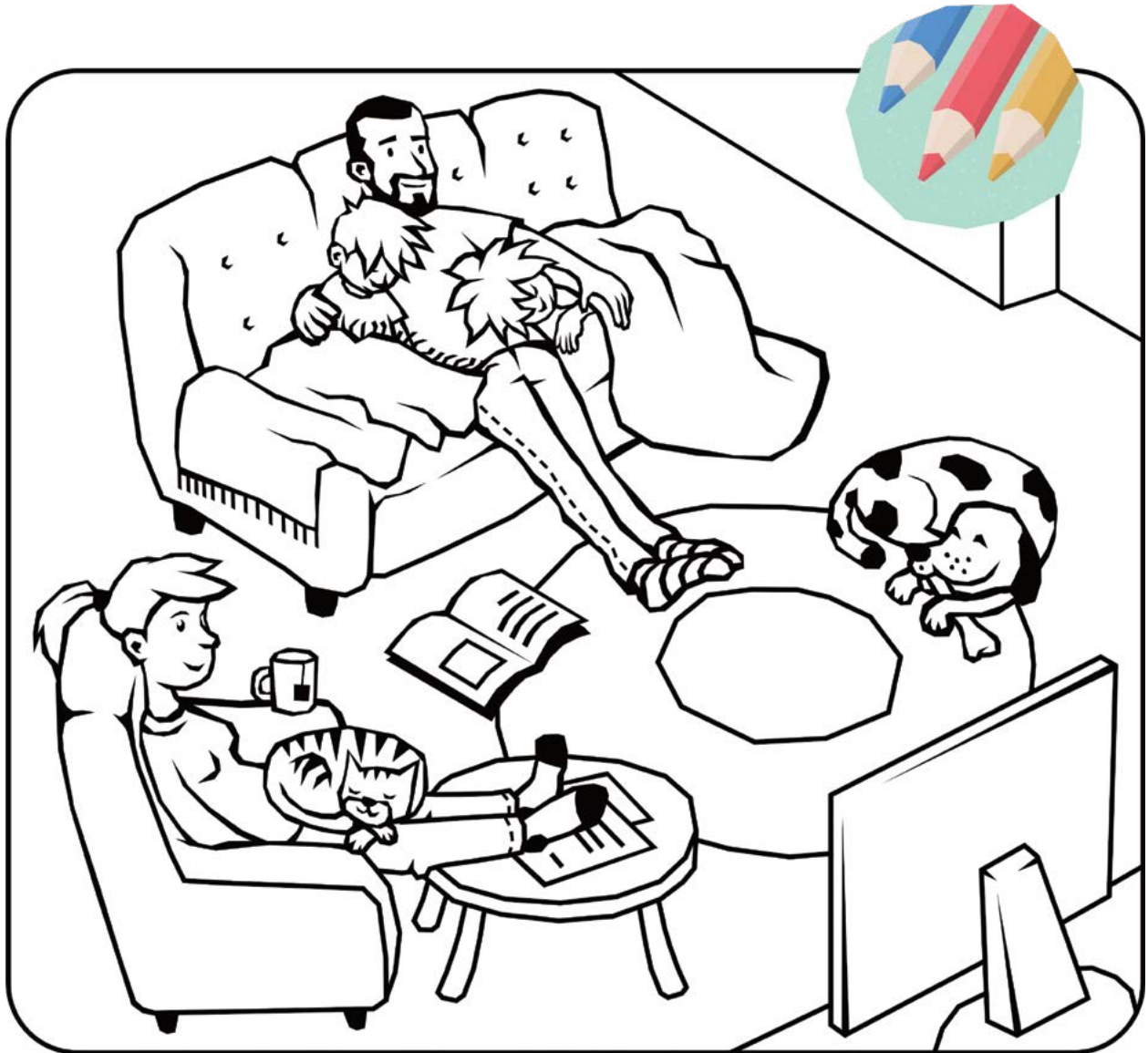
That evening we had an amazing dinner with lots of healthy food!
